2018 District Survey

This week. Hillside students and staff are completing the Needham Public Schools 2018 District Survey. Parents can complete the survey now, too. This biennial survey, administered since 2001, allows each school to celebrate strengths, respond to areas needing improvement, and measure progress toward the District Goals. The cumulative results will be shared with us!

Since the last District survey was administered in 2016, Needham Public Schools took a number of action steps. Here are a few examples: In response to requests for improved transportation service, the School Committee approved funding for the addition of school buses and a late bus; school space issues were addressed; more STEAM programs were added; the process was launched for community involvement in developing a Portrait of A Needham Graduate, and so much more. Our own School Council worked with staff to consider how to respond to the survey findings as we updated Hillside's School Improvement Plan.

Spring Allergies

I have seen many students for spring allergy symptoms this week. Sometimes we are doing everything right and still the pollen prevails. Or, sometimes, children refuse to do what's best for them and ignore our advice! Please check with your pediatrician before giving any medications.

Seasonal allergy symptoms are hard to reverse once they start, so the best action is prevention. The over-the-counter, nonsedating medications work well when taken daily. The same is true for antihistamine eye drops. Please consider giving them in the morning before school.

Other Preventive Measures:

Wear hats and sunglasses for recess Wash hands and face when coming indoors Keep car and house windows closed Shower before bed Wash bed sheets more frequently Use saline nasal sprays as needed to rinse nasal passages




Please Join Us As We Roll Out the Red Carpet for Our Faculty and Staff!
