Children Entering Grades K-5 Libraries Rock! Summer Reading Program



Children of all ages, up to those entering 5th Grade in the fall, are invited to sign up for Summer Reading at the Needham Free Public Library. Children record the amount of time they

spend reading, or are read aloud to, using a paper or online reading log. Children receive a free book and a voucher for a WNBA summer basket ball game when they sign up. They receive a small toy prize for every 4 hours of reading, up to 16 hours. Children who complete the program by reading or being read to for 16 hours by August 5th will receive a second free book and a ticket to the August 5th Pawtucket Pawsox baseball game. They will also be eligible to win grand prizes through random drawing. Children who read for more than 16 hours will also receive a free kids meal at Friendly's and be entered in a state-wide drawing for prizes from the Boston Bruins.

The theme this summer is music - Libraries Rock! The school that has the highest percentage of students who read for the most hours over the summer will receive a Rock and Roll trophy for their school.
