# **News from Dr. Maloney**

The highlight of this week was the groundbreaking for the new Sunita Williams Elementary School, which took place this morning. The new school is now officially in the building stage, giving everyone in the HES community much to be thankful for during this holiday season.

With Thanksgiving only days away, I asked students in a Kindergarten class and in a fifth grade class to tell me what they were most thankful for this year. The Kindergartners thoughtfully shared a range of answers that could be categorized as environmental (forests, world, earth, land, life, water), pet loving (dog, fish), and family (Mom, sister, our company at Thanksgiving, family, parents). There was also a Kindergartener who said "the people who protect us" and another who said "God who gave us all this stuff." Their remaining answers included: cake, all the food, and buying a toy truck. By contrast the fifth graders, with the benefit of five more years of life experience, were almost unanimous in being thankful first and foremost for their families. Many also added answers such as good health, books, friends, opportunity to come here for a year and a good school.


