### News from Dr. Maloney

Last week I wrote that teachers were observing some student behavior that was not always reflecting Hillside values ("Work hard, Be nice.") or the Needham Public Schools core value of community ("A culture that encourages communication, understanding, and is actively anti-racist."). On Wednesday morning before the late arrival of our students, teachers and staff began to work on two important initiatives: 1) Supporting Anti-racist, Anti-bias practices and 2) Encouraging respectful, kind and polite behavior in and out of the classrooms. We are in the very early planning stages, but you will be hearing more about how we can partner to reinforce these values in our students/your children. The importance of this work was underscored by the disquieting news from Needham High School that racist and homophobic graffiti had been written on school walls. It is imperative that all students feel safe in our schools.

#### Non-Couch Potatoes Go to State Tournament

The Non-Couch Potatoes are a First LEGO League (FLL) team composed of Hillside fifth graders Sam Doff, Josh Lee, Gabe Pressman and Dylan Schaffstein all in their rookie season. FLL teams across the world have been working since August to solve interesting problems based on this year's theme of hydrodynamics. They present their solutions and compete in a LEGO robot game at qualifying tournaments around this time of the year. Inspired by rainwater collecting roofs that have existed on the island of Bermuda for 400 years, the Non-Couch Potatoes developed a new roof system that can collect water during rainy weather, but also captures solar energy when it is sunny. These ideas were shared with the Hillside Green Team and a

representative from Needham Green Collaborative and their feedback was incorporated into their tournament presentation.

The Non-Couch Potatoes set a 100-point goal for robot mission scoring when the season started in September. On Saturday, December 2nd the team competed in the Shrewsbury qualifying tournament with 44 other teams from across the state. They started the day with a great run and then hit some bumps due to some poor robot playing field conditions. A good showing in the project judging reinvigorated the team and they found themselves only 5 points shy of their goal for the final qualifying round. The team tweaked their approach using lessons learned that day and notched a 120 point final round that propelled them past their goal! Their hard work was rewarded by an invitation to the Massachusetts Championship First LEGO League Tournament on December 16th.


